



## Patient Access Update

**Access to your on line medical records for Patients registered for Patient Access now includes access to previous blood test results since 2015 and access to documents as of January 2017. The benefits of this increased access is to allow you to compare results with previous test results and to check if letters have been sent or received from the hospital.**

### Summary of Services available with Patient Access:

- *Order repeat medication*
- *Book appointments online with a GP/HCA*
- *View your blood test/x-ray results*
- *View documents, for example: correspondence received by the Practice from Hospitals/community services regarding your care.*
- *View your immunisations*
- *View your allergies*
- *View your detailed coded medical records*

### Applying for Access is simple:-

**Step 1: Complete an application form which you can collect in person from reception at both practices or download from the Practice website.**

**Step 2: Provide proof of identity (1x photo ID, 1x proof of residence)**

**Step 3: Your application will be processed within approximately 3 weeks and you will be notified to collect your registration document to register on line.**

**\*NEW\* We also offer patients the opportunity to receive a SMS text message appointment reminder service and you can also receive your blood test results as a SMS text message. For further information, please speak to a Receptionist about this service.**
