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Shrewsbury & Telford Hospital X-ray and Scan's Reporting Update

The Practice is receiving a high volume of calls from patients who are requesting if their x-ray or scan results have been received from the Hospitals. Following the disruption caused to the NHS services by Covid 19, Hospital Radiology recovery remains under severe pressure and as a result the waiting times are longer than they would like.

The table below is an example of the waiting and reporting times that Shrewsbury and Telford Hospitals published in November 2022.

How Shrewsbury & Telford Hospital Radiology are improving current waiting times

With the use of an MRI mobile van located at Royal Shrewsbury Hospital (RSH) and CT mobile van located at Princess Royal Hospital (PRH). A new outpatient scanning suite at Royal Shrewsbury Hospital is now operational which includes a CT scanner and MRI scanner. Recruitment is ongoing for all areas within Radiology to help fill current vacancies and to extend the current workforce due to the increase in demand.

By sharing this information, we hope that we will provide our patients with a better understanding of the reporting times and reduce the number of phone call queries that we are currently receiving.
