# Have You Had Your Flu Vaccination Yet?

Who is Eligible for the Influenza Vaccine:-

- Over 65 years of age
- Pregnant ladies
- Patients with; COPD, Lung Disease, severe asthma (requires inhaled steroids)
- Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD) Stage 3 or above
- Immunosuppressed due to disease or medications/chemo
- Diabetics
- People who have had a CVA/TIA
- Heart Disease
- Neurological conditions including MS, Cerebral palsy, Learning disabilities
- Asplenic patients
- BMI over 40
- Carers

If you are in one of these risk groups, you are more likely to develop potentially serious complications of flu such as pneumonia, so it is worth having the flu vaccination every year to protect you.
